Meta-Analysis is among the simplest of hierarchical models. Among the uses for meta-analysis and meta-analytic ideas is in prior construction. I detail some uses of meta-analysis for prior construction in two (time permitting) situations where (1) In a real sense there is no more data to be collected, (2) In a pharmaceutical example where proper priors give better frequentist behavior than the frequentist analysis.
